**S.R.O. No. 547/2000.**-In exercise of the powers conferred by sub- section (1) of Section 37 of the Kerala Highway Protection Act 1999 (6 of 2000), the Government of Kerala hereby constitute the appellate authorities mentioned in column (2) of Schedule I and Schedule II below, and under sub-section (2) of the said section authorise the officers specified in column (3) of the said Schedules, to exercise the powers of the appellate authority over the areas specified against each in column (4) thereof, namely:-

#### Explanatory Note

(This does not form part of the Notification, but is intended to indicate its general purport)

Sub-section (1) of section 37 of the Kerala Highway Protection Act, 1999 (6 of 2000), authorise the State Government to constitute as many appellate authorities, as may be necessary, for the purpose of the Act and sub-section (2) of the said section empowers Government to authorise any officer not below the rank of Superintending Engineer in the Public Works Department to exercise the powers of the appellate authority in such areas as may be specified in the notification. Government have decided to constitute seven appellate authorities and to authorise certain officers in the rank of Superintending Engineers of the Public Works Department to exercise the powers of the appellate authority under the Act.

This Notification is intended to achieve the above object.
