As per the G.O. read above Engineers were being deputed from the PWD for higher studies from 1978 to 1991. The scheme has not been available for several years since 1992. Appendix

Scheme for deputation of Engineers in PWD to the P.G. Courses

- (a). Suitable and willing officers shall submit their application with bio data, marklist and degree certificate in duplicate.
- (b). They should possess a minimum of 2 years of regular service in the department and should have declared their probation and should not be aged over 40 years, as on the date of application for the course.
- (c). They must have a minimum of 60% marks in the qualifying examination.
- (d). They shall execute a bond on non-judicial stamp paper worth Rs. 100/- to the effect that they shall serve the Government for a minimum period of 10 years on successful completion of training within the prescribed period, failing which they will have to pay to Government the entire amount spent by Government for the training together with a penalty of Rs.1,00,000/- (Rupees One Lakh only) by way of liquidated damages.
- (e). During the period of deputation they will be paid pay and allowances admissible to them.
- (f). Tuition fee, examination fee, caution deposit and other miscellaneous fee will be borne by the deputed officer.
- (g). They will be eligible for TA for journey from their Head Quarters to the place of training and back to the place they are posted on termination of the course under Rule 58 (a) Part II KSRs.
- (h). The period of training including the period to and fro journey will be treated as duty, under Rule 12(7) (iii) Part I KSRs.
- (i). They will not be paid any post graduate allowances, compensatory allowances or deputation allowance during the period of training.

(j). Those who fail to complete the course or discontinue it, shall refund the entire emoluments they received during the period.

(k). In the case of trainees whose period of deputation is extended due to non completion of the course within the stipulated time, they will have to execute revised agreement in conformity with the total period of deputation as revised and re-fixed as per Condition no. (IX) of the GO(P) No.303/70/Fin dt. 12.05.70.

(l). Equal number of equivalent posts vacated by the officers on deputation will be kept unfilled.

(m). The cost of extended period (both tuition fee and all other charges) shall not be borne by Government.

(n). Total number of such deputation in a year should be limited, to a maximum of 3 on all categories.

(o). After completion of such course, the Officer/Engineer should not ask for any particular post/rank/place of posting.

(p). After training as far as possible, the incumbent should be posted in the field in which he specialized in the post graduation Course.
