Sub:- Public Works Department – Ensuring hindrance free land before tendering work – Guidelines to be followed by all field officers for awarding works – reg.

It has come to the notice of Government that many works are being tendered and awarded for execution before ensuring availability of hindrance free land, resulting in delayed execution of works/Court Cases/Pre-mature termination of works etc. causing huge loss to the Government Exchequer and in many cases the proposals were dropped due to non-availability of land.


In order to overcome the above difficulties in the interest of facilitating expeditious implementation of various schemes/projects of the Public Works Department, and to ensure judicious allocation of financial resources, all concerned officers are hereby directed to strictly ensure availability of hindrance free land, before tendering any work in future. All Officers are hereby directed to follow the above direction scrupulously so that the officers concerned shall be made liable for the losses sustained to Govt, if any; in the future.
