Flag on United Nation's Day-24<sup>th</sup> October - Instructions issued -  
reg.**

**Ref: Letter No.2/10/2016- Public Dated 13.10.2016 from the Ministry of  
Home Affairs, Government of India**

The United Nation's Day is observed on 24<sup>th</sup> October every year. The United Nation's Flag may, therefore, be flown on that day along with the National Flag on all buildings on which National Flag is regularly flown in the State. The United Nation's Flag is, however, not to be flown on Raj Bhavan and buildings housing the Kerala Legislative Assembly and the High Court.

In terms of Para 3.36 of the Flag Code of India, 2002 " When the United Nation's Flag is flown along with National Flag, it can be displayed on either side of the National Flag. The general practice is to fly the National Flag on the extreme right with reference to the direction which it is facing (ie, extreme left of an observer facing the masts flying the Flags)"

I am to request you to inform all concerned and observe the above guidelines scrupulously.
