ORDER

Sri. A. M. Ashraf, while working as Assistant Executive Engineer, Road Safety, Office of the Chief Engineer, Roads & Bridges, Thiruvananthapuram entered on commuted leave for 60 days from 19.6.2006 to 17.8.2006 on personal ground. But he had not reported for duty in the above office on expiry of the leave. Thereafter he applied for Leave Without Allowances for the period from 18.8.2006 to 31.3.2008 on personal ground. Government initiated disciplinary action against Shri. A.M. Ashraf, Assistant Executive Engineer and he was served with memo of charges read above for his failure to report for duty in the office on expiry of leave. Even though the delinquent officer received the memo of charges / statement of allegation on 30.11.2009, he has not furnished any written statement of defence against the same, till date.

2. As per Government Order read above major disciplinary action as contemplated in Rule 15 of KCS (CC & A) Rules 1960 was initiated against him and the Deputy Chief Engineer (Vigilance) was appointed as Enquiry Officer. As per letter read above the enquiry officer submitted the preliminary report to Government and recommend to issue a posting order to Sri. A. M. Ashraf as Assistant Executive Engineer without prejudice to the disciplinary action initiated against him.


