# National Roads & Highways Summit

India's road network of 4.7 million kms length is the second-largest in the world. Out of this, national highways account for 70,934 km, state highways for 163,898 km, and major district roads, rural and urban roads collectively account for 4.46 million km.

Roads remain the most important means of transport, accounting for 85% and 65% of passenger and freight traffic, respectively, in India. National highways account for a mere 2% of the total road length, but carry 40% of the total road traffic. The government provides various incentives for private and foreign sector investment in the roads sector. 100% foreign direct investment (FDI) under the automatic route is allowed for support services to land transport such as operation of highway bridges, toll roads, and vehicular tunnels; services incidental to transport such as cargo handling is incidental to land transport; and maintenance of roads and highways offered on build-operate-transfer (BOT) basis, including collection of toll. But still the sector is not attracting enough investors.

- To discuss the role of allied industries like Cement and Steel in the development of Roads and Highways
