The Kerala PWD has a departmental website (www.keralapwd.gov.in) which is being updated with news related to the department, progress reports of works, status of works, etc. Important documents, circulars, directions, transfer and posting orders, seniority lists of staff, training programmes undertaken by the department, etc are available in the site. Hence all the departmental officers are directed to login to PWD website daily so that they are abreast with the latest directions and orders that are related to Kerala PWD. All the tenders invited by the PWD offices should be published in the PWD website without failure by the tender inviting officers by utilizing Project Management module.

The news regarding the inaugural functions, photographs of the projects, functions of Ministers and other important departmental news in your jurisdiction should be transmitted to IT cell so as to publish these items in the PWD website as well as in the website of Public information Cell of PWD. All the officers are requested to personally look into the matter and make maximum use of this facility by either mailing these details to itcell@pwd.kerala.gov.in or transmitting the details in soft copy to the IT cell.

All the concerned Officers are requested to login into the PWD website daily. The refresher training (walk-in training) of the Project Management Module/other modules is being given on every Wednesdays in the IT training hall, Thiruvananthapuram. The officers who require refresher training on Modules of PWD Website can utilize the above facility. The date of training shall also be published in the PWD website.

It may be noted that so many grievances are received through the PWD website and the same is assigned to the concerned Superintending Engineers or Executive Engineers as the case may be by the Grievance administrator of this office. The replies to this grievances should be given by the concerned officers through their intranet account in the website. But it is noticed that the replies are being received after a long delay without any reasons. The public who are sending their grievances are complaining about this inordinate delay.

All the Superintending Engineers / Executive Engineers are here by directed to monitor the grievance received and personal attention should be given for timely replying (maximum 5 days) so as to furnish a reply to the grievance.

The contents of the circular should be implemented from this date without any failure.
