S. R. O. No. 395/2016.—In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 2 of the Kerala Public Services Act, 1968 (19 of 1968) and in supersession of G. O.(Ms.) No. 173/PW dated 15th June, 1965, the Government of Kerala hereby make the following Special Rules for the Kerala Architectural Wing State Service in the Kerala State Public Works Department, namely:—

RULES

- 1. Short title and commencement.—(1) These rules may be called the Kerala State Public Works Department (Architectural Wing) State Service Special Rules, 2016.
 - (2) They shall come into force at once.
- 2. Constitution.—The service shall consist of the following categories of Officers, namely:—

Category 1	••	Chief Architect
Category 2		Deputy Chief Architect
Category 3	••	Senior Architect
Category 4	••	Deputy Architect
Category 5	••	Landscape Architect
Category 6	••	Technical Assistant (Architecture)
Category 7	••	Architectural Assistant.

3. Method of Appointment.—Appointment to the categories of posts shall be made in the manner specified in the Table 1 given below:

- 2. In the absence of suitable candidates in item (1) above, by promotion from suitable candidates in the Category 7 having Architectural qualification.
- 7. Architectural Assistant
- (i) By transfer from Architectural Draftsman Grade I under the Kerala Architectural Subordinate Service:
- (ii) By direct recruitment.

Note:—40% of the posts shall be filled up by transfer in the ratio 3:2 between Diploma and Certificate holders from Kerala Architectural Subordinate Service. The remaining 60% of posts shall be filled up by direct recruitment. 10% of the posts under direct recruitment quota shall be filled up by direct recruitment from among persons who possess qualifications required and have rendered service of not less than two years in any of the categories under Kerala Architectural Subordinate Service.

Note:—The posts of Technical Assistant (Architecture) (ie. only those having requisite qualification for the post of Deputy Architect) and the Deputy Architect are interchangeable.

4. Qualification regarding age.—No person shall be eligible for appointment by direct recruitment if he/she has not completed 18 years of age or has completed 36 years of age with usual relaxation of age admissible to candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Communities as on the first day of the year in which applications for appointment are invited by the Kerala Public Service Commission.

Provided that persons in the Kerala Architectural State Service and the Kerala Architectural Subordinate Service, who possess necessary qualifications shall be exempted from the upper age limit prescribed above.

5. Other qualifications.—No person shall be eligible for appointment to any of the category specified in column (1) of the Table 2 below, by the method specified in the corresponding entry in column (2) thereof unless he/she possesses the qualifications specified in the corresponding entry in column (3) thereof.

- 6. Probation:—Every person appointed to any of the categories by promotion shall be, from the date on which he/she joins duty, on probation for a period of 6 months on duty within a continuous period of one year. Probation for direct recruits/ by transfer candidates, shall be two years on duty within a continuous period of three years.
- 7. Appointing Authority:—Appointing authority for categories 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6 shall be the Government of Kerala and that for category 7 shall be the Chief Architect.
- 8. Tests.—Every person appointed to any of the categories mentioned in Rule 2 shall, within the period of probation, possess Executive Officers Test and PWD Manual Test conducted by the Public Service Commission if he/she has not already passed the same.

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9. Savings:—All persons who are members of this service without Architectural qualification, as on the date of commencement of these rules shall be given exemption from possessing the qualifications prescribed by these rules for the posts held by them and for the promotion from Subordinate Service and are free to opt for the new Special Rules on their acquisition for the qualifications included in the Table 2.

Explanatory Note

(This does not form part of the notification, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

The rules relating to the qualifications and method of appointment to the Architectural Wing of the State PWD was formulated by the Government of Kerala in G. O. (Ms.) No. 173/PW dated 15th June, 1965, when there was insufficient number of architecturally qualified hands available in the State to operate the wing. Therefore the qualifications prescribed for appointment were more related to Civil Engineering professionals working in various departments. Now the State is having sufficient number of architecturally trained personnel from various institutions for appointment to this wing. Further, the introduction of the Architects Act, 1972 by the Government of India (made applicable to all States and Union Territories), required its provisions to be built into these rules. Hence the existing rules had to be revised to effect the same.

Accordingly as per G. O. (Ms.) No. 19/2011/PWD dated 1-3-2011 one post of Landscape Architect was created in the cadre of Assistant Architect and one post of Architectural Head Draftsman was upgraded as Technical Assistant (Architectural) in the cadre of Assistant Architect. The posts of Architect, Assistant Architect and Architectural Head Draftsman were re-designated as Senior Architect, Deputy Architect and Architectural Assistant respectively. Government have decided to formulate a new Special Rules for the State Service of the Architectural Wing of the State PWD incorporating all the changes made as above and in consonance with the Architects Act, 1972.

The notification is intended to achieve the above object.
